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Wine Find: 2007 Laurenz und Sophie Singing Gruner Veltliner

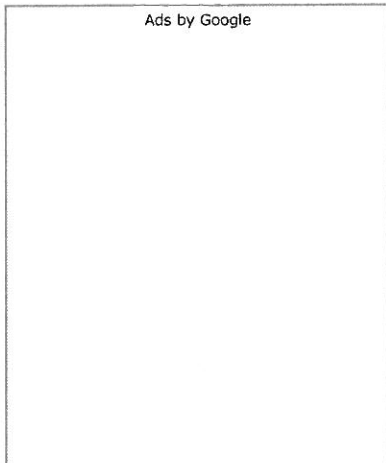

Gruner veltliner is one of the great but little-known white-wine grapes. Its cultivation is almost entirely confined to Austria, one of the great but little-known wine countries. This dry, steely wine combines impressive tensile strength with deep flavors of pear, cherry, minerals, herbs and a hint of white pepper. A tad richer and more complex is the 2006 Laurenz V. "Charming" Gruner Veltliner, but its \$25 price tag gives the gold to "Singing" on value points.
